APPROVAL OF AGENDA: On motion by Trustee Olguin and seconded by Trustee Castro, the agenda was approved as delivered.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: None.

LIBRARY MANAGER'S REPORT:

- 1KBb4K – 7 children completed the program. They and their parents were recognized during the completion ceremony.
- Building Improvements – landscaping is improving. The grass was reseeded and some old trees will be trimmed. Public Works is also assisting us with improvements to the inside lighting of the building.
- Provided tote bags to Kids and Teens n' Badges participants
- Held first Vintage Club Get Together. 18 ladies attended. It was great to hear how this monthly packet has positively impacted their lives.
- Continued receiving class visits through December and January is almost booked
- Held the annual Happy Holidays family night with 64 kids and 50 adults in attendance
- David A. Tittle presented his first book at the library. About 20 people attended on a Saturday evening.
- Mayor Pro-Tem Calderon secured a \$600 donation for the purchase of bikes to use as incentives for the 500 Books before Junior High program

Trustee Castro enjoyed helping during the past Happy Holidays program. She really liked the fact that her son received a letter back from Santa. Chair Ayala enjoyed reading to children during the same program and mentioned that one of the attendees told her that she had a captivating voice and returned to listen to another story. A girl asked if she could pick a book of her choice, so she did. Some other parents asked for readings of books in Spanish. Trustee Pacheco also enjoyed helping and is grateful that free program opportunities are available to the community.

CONSENT ITEMS:

1. Approval of Minutes for Special Meeting on December 2, 2025. On motion by Trustee Castro and seconded by Chair Ayala the minutes were approved as delivered.

DISCUSSION AND POTENTIAL ACTION ITEMS:

2. California Library Association's Lunch @ the Library Partner Project – Ms. Legaspi applied for additional funding to continue providing books and art activities for children. The prices of books went up, and general fund money was used to cover the additional expenses. The additional expense amounted to \$323.38. This program started today and will run until the first week in May. Up to 25 children will be able to receive a book during lunch at the library program.
3. NEW Program – Kids Book Club – This program has been in Ms. Legaspi's Wishlist for many years now. It is an opportunity for the library to engage children with books before they go to junior high. Children will be able to share about the book they are currently reading and suggest titles for future meetings. It will be offered on the first and third Friday of the month.
4. NEW Program – Sensory Playtime – This program will be offered once per month and will be led by a volunteer. The program will include a warmup activity, story reading with visuals, an art activity and a movement activity.
5. Every Story Counts – January 26-31, 2026 – the California State Library would like to collect information from the community about why and how they use their public library. A survey will be available for the public to fill out. Survey will be shared in person, via email and through social media.
6. Carnegie Technology Center Closed – January 26-February 2, 2026- Staff member who covers the center requested time off and there is not enough staff to send a replacement without heavily impacting the library. Ms. Legaspi asked the board to approve closing the center those days. The English as a Second Language classes will not be impacted. Staff will go and open and close the center for the class. On motion by Trustee Castro and second by Chair Ayala and voted unanimously, the closure of the center from January 26th through February 2nd was approved.
7. Calexico READS – Book Clubs – Ms. Legaspi reviewed the various book club opportunities available to the community in addition to the reading challenge programs such as 1K Books before Kindergarten and 500 Books before Junior High.

8. Friends of the Library Report – A new fundraising campaign will begin this year. \$26 for 2026. This funding provides additional monetary support for library programs.

- Book bikes for outreach
- Family workstations
- Light tables
- Sewing machines

The deadline for the application is February 6, 2026.

An application was submitted for one (1) Charlie cart to be used during cooking class sessions and two (2) light tables.

This project is supported in whole or in part by the U.S. Institute of Museum and Library Services under the provisions of the Library Services and Technology Act, administered in California by the State Librarian.

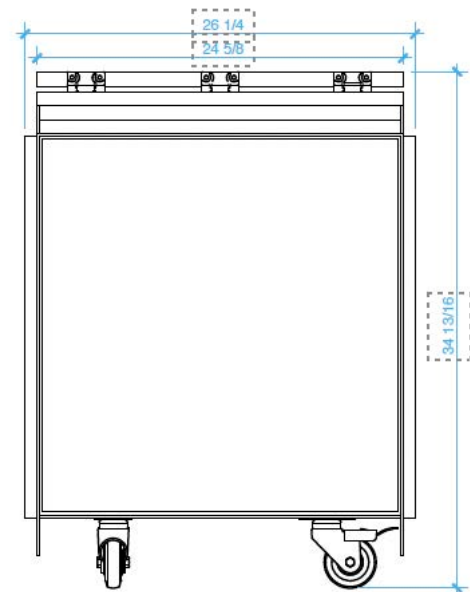

Program Cost \$14,500 (USD) + \$1000 flat rate shipping. Orders in CA also incur local sales tax not included in the above costs. Carts shipped to Hawaii, Alaska, Puerto Rico or Canada have separate shipping rate in lieu of the flat rate charge.

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







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
